SARADA NAVARATHRI 2025

The Sri Kanchi Mahaswami Vidya Mandir is a manifestation of the desire of the Sages of Kanchi to evolve an education system that combines the best of all. The Vidya Mandir is a bold experiment to demonstrate that the study of Vedas and pursuit of secular education need not be in conflict. The Vidya Mandir is set amidst serene surroundings at Rajakilpakkam, Tambaram East, Chennai. Spread over more than 6 acres of prime land, the Vidya Mandir has a CBSE School, Dr. L. M. Singhvi Veda Patashala, a Mahaswami Mandiram, a memorial for Bharat Ratna Dr. M. S. Subbulakshmi, temples for Devi Kamakshi, Vidya Ganapathi, Saraswathi and Mahalingaswami. There are several exhibitions and museums which bring out the glory and the greatness of Indian culture and hoary traditions of the over 2500 years of Sri Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam.

It was inaugurated by their Holinesses Jagadguru Sri Jayendra Saraswathi Swamigal and Sri. Sankara Vijayendra Saraswathi Swamigal on 4th June 2010. The Mahakumbabishekam of Devi Kamakshi Temple and other temples in the campus were performed at the holy hands of the Jagadgurus.

Chennites were distinctly fortunate when their Holinesses celebrated the Sarada Navarathri Mahotsavam in Sri Kanchi Mahaswami Vidya Mandir campus between 25th September and 4th October 2014. After a gap of 12 years (last performed in 2002) the Sankaracharyas performed Navarathri in Chennai. Again after a gap of 11 years, the present Jagadguru Sankaracharyas will be performing the Sarada Navarathri Mahotsavam between 22nd September and 2nd October 2025. Special Japas, Parayanams and Homams would be performed during this period for the welfare of humanity at large. The Trikala Sri. Maha Tripurasundari Sametha Sri. Chandramouleeswarai Swami Puja, Abishekams, cultural programmes, a Grand Kolu and a Sahasra Chandi Mahayagnam would be conducted under the guidance of Br. Sri. Dinakara Sharma are but a few highlights of the Navarathri festival. During the nine days of worship, the Goddess would be adorned with special Alankarams


on each day. Devotees are requested to have darshan of the Goddess, the Sages of Kanchi and be beneficiaries of their blessings.

This is the first ever Vijaya yatra of His Holiness Sri Satya Chandrasekarendra Saraswathi Swamigal to Chennai. As both their Holinesses would perform the Sarada Navarathri Mahotsavam between 22nd September and 2nd October 2025, it would be a rare opportunity, blessings and privilege for Chennaites to offer their Bhikshavandanam to the Jagadgurus. The Sri. Kanchi Mahaswami Trust solicits generous contributions from the devotees for conducting the Navarathri festival. May the presiding deity of the Vidya Mandir, the Mahaswami of Kanchi, the Jagadguru Sankaracharyas of the Peetam and the Supreme Mother shed their grace on all of us.

NAVARATHRI NAYAKIS

During Navarathri, we perform pooja to Durga Parameswari, the Parasakthi, Mahalakshmi and Saraswathi. All of them are only one Parasakthi. It is this truth that is conveyed by Lalitha Sahasranamam while describing the Paradevatha as one who creates (Srushti Karthri – Brahma Rupa), protects and nurtures (Gopthri – Govinda Rupini) and carries out destruction – Samharam (Samharini – Rudra Rupa). The same shakti which is Lalithai and Durgai is also Mahalakshmi and Saraswati. In Lakshmi Ashtotram, the prayer “Brahma Vishnu Sivathmikayai Namah” occurs. In Saraswati Ashtotram too, Brahma Vishnu Sivathmikayai Namah occurs. These makes it clear to us that it is only Sakthi that creates, protects and destroys. Only Parasakthi manifests in different forms and carries out different functions. As Durga, she gives valour, Sakthi etc.; as Mahalakshmi she gives wealth and as Saraswati, she gives jnana.

May we worship Ambal, Mahalakshmi and Saraswati Devi and be blessed with all powers, wealth and good buddhi (intellect).



BHIKSHA VANDANAM TO THE JAGADGURUS



Bhagavan Vishnu took 10 avatars and was born as the eighth child of the Vasudeva – Devaki couple and was named Krishna. He gave to the world the veda Upanishad saram i.e. Bhagavad Gita and was proclaimed the Jagath Guru. On 13.3.1969, the eighth child was born to the great exponent of Rig Veda, Shri. M. Krishnamoorthy Sastrigal and Smt. Ambalakshmi and named as Sankaranarayanan. He was initiated into Sanyasa at a tender age of 13 like the Mahaswami and was anointed as the 70th pontiff in the Guru Parampara of the venerated Sri. Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam. His thoughts, vision, planning and execution aligned to contemporary needs but at the same time rooted in tradition and sampradaya are easily visible as He guides the Peetam and the large fraternity of devotees. The Mutt had gone through turbulent times in the decades that passed by. The grace and benediction of the Mahaswami and Pujyasri Jayendra Saraswathi Swamigal has seen it emerge stronger from these adversities and under the pontificate of Sri. Sankara Vijayendra Saraswathi Swamigal, the Mutt is destined to reach great heights in the service to humanity.

Sri Duddu Satya Venkatasurya Subrahmanya Ganesha Sarma Dravid (born 29th April 1999) was anointed as the 71st pontiff of the venerated Sri Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam on the auspicious day of Akshaya Tirtiya on 30th April 2025. He was born to Br.Sri Srinivasa Surya Subrahmanya Dhanvantri and Smt. Alamelu Mangadevi. This day coincided with the Sri Balarama Jayanti (8th avataram of the Lord), Visvvasu year Uttarayanam 17th day of Chitrai, Shukla paksham, Rohini nakshatram, Wednesday. Such a day appeared 17 years ago and would come again 27 years later. The sacred event also coincided with the 2534th Jayanti Mahotsavam of Sri Adi Sankaracharya (on 2.5.2025). Born in Tuni, Annavaram, Nizamabad District, Andhra Pradesh, the young Swamiji mastered the three vedas : Rig, Yajur and Sama. A Salakshana Ghanapati, he completed his studies in Shadangas, Dasopanishads and was pursuing Shastric studies in Kancheepuram.

The 70th Acharya Sri Sankara Vijayendra Saraswathi Swamigal after giving him the

Sanyasa Diksha in Devi Kamakshi Temple gave him the name “Sri Satya Chandrasekarendra Saraswathi Sankaracharya Swamigal” in the hoary Guru Parampara carrying the title of Indra Saraswathi. He drew on the words from Swasti Vachakam of the Mutt “सत्यव्रत नामाङ्कित काञ्ची दिव्यक्षेत्रे”, and since the incumbent Sankaracharya hailed from the holy town of Anavaram in Andhra Pradesh with the famous shrine of Sri Veera Venkata Satya Narayana Swami carrying the name Satya in anointing the new Sankaracharya with the title starting with “Sri Satya”.

This is the first ever Vijaya yatra of His Holiness Sri Satya Chandrasekarendra Saraswathi Swamigal to Chennai. As both their Holinesses would perform the Sarada Navarathri Mahotsavam between 22nd September and 2nd October 2025, it would be a rare opportunity, blessings and privilege for Chennaites to offer their Bhikshavandanam to the Jagadgurus. It has been decided to offer a minimum of **108 Bhikshavandanams** on each of the Navarathri days with an aggregate minimum of **1080 Bhikshavandanams** during this period. The Bhikshavandanam Kanikkai has been fixed at **Rs. 5000/-**. SARADA NAVARATHRI 2025

Sarada Navarathri is the most auspicious of the four Navarathris for Amba's worship in a year. She herself called it as 'Maha Pooja' in Chandi "Sharadakala Maha Pooja Kriyato". During the nine day long festival, the first three days, Amba is worshipped as 'Sri Durga', the next three days as 'Sri Lakshmi' and the last three days as 'Sri Saraswathi'. Jaganmatha is a dispeller of ignorance, i.e. darkness of the mind and so in the nature of 'Deepa'. She also exists in the Deepa form 'Deepa Devi Roopa twam'. Worshipping the Deepa bestows the fruits of worshipping the Parashakti. Amba 'Sri Durga' is worshipped as 'Kanyakumari' as it is stated 'Kanyakumari Demahi'. Amba is pleased by the worship of Sumangalees or when worshipped by the Sumangalees as it is stated 'Sumangalyarchana Preetayai Namaha'. She is pleased by worshipping or being worshipped by Veda vatus. She herself is 'Vidya Rupayai Namaha' and 'Vidyadhara Supoojitayai Namaha'. She is pleased and blesses when Vipra Bhojanam 'Brahma Bhajanam' takes place alongwith Homams and the water is sprinkled 'Vipraanaam Bhojanair Homaihi Prokshaneeya Aharnisham'. When all these are conducted in same place in a sequence and that too during Sarada Navarathri Maha Pooja, the fruits of her blessings will be showered on her devotees infinite.

Sarada Navarathri 2025 is planned on the basis of all these well established means of worshipping the Parashakti to bless the world.

- **Brahma Bhojanam** – 24 Ritwiks Gayatri Sankya daily covering a total of 216 ritwiks.
- **504 Deepa Pooja** on the Prathama day so that the light of knowledge sanctifies the whole of 9 days of worship.
- **251 Kanya Pooja** on the 3rd day when 'Durga' worship is completed, Kanya Pooja bestows the blessings of 'Ma Durga' to overcome all difficulties in life.
- **251 Suhasini Pooja** – on the Shasti and Anuradha Nakshatra day, the Mahaswami's Star day, when Sri Lakshmi worship is fulfilled, Suhasini Pooja is certain to shower Lakshmi Kataksham i.e. prosperity to all.



- **500 Vatu Pooja** on the Ashtami day on Moola Nakshatram day occurs on the Saraswathi Aarohanam day, Vatu Pooja bestows Saraswathis Vilasam to all.

SAHASRA CHANDI MAHAYAGNAM

Widely known and revered as Devimahatmyam (Glory of Divine Mother) this cosmic hymn is presented to the world in a dialogue form between Markandeya and Kroshtuki in the Markandeya Puranam. Though the great work was not authored by the Maharshi himself, it has simply originated from time immemorial and has been handed down over thousands of generations as is the case with Vedas.



“यदो वेदो ध्यानधिर्हि तदथ सप्तशति स्मृता” says Bhuvaneswari Samhitha.

Sapthasathi has its main theme centered around The Supreme Shakthi and elaborates on the worship of the Divine Mother. As propounded by the Tantra “Sakthi is the origin and source of all.

“शिवः शक्त्य युक्तो यदि भवति शक्तः प्रभावितुम्”

Such is the greatness of Amba, the Lokamatha that Adi Sankara in the opening verse of Soundarya Lahari says that one needs to have a lot of merit accumulated to worship Her.

“प्रणन्तुं स्तोतुं वा कथमकृतपुण्यः प्रभवतित्वां”

The Scripture Sapthasathy offers 700 valuable slokas divided into 3 episodes covering 13 chapters dealing with 4 incarnations of mother

“Maheswari, Mahakali, Mahalakshmi, Mahasaraswathi expressed as Kriyashakti, Icchashakti, Gnyanashakti” etc. Chandipath is recognised as a jewel of sruthis and a great Sadhana Sasthra, which has to be recited with great devotion and discipline in the method our tradition has prescribed.

“यथा अश्वो देवानां तथा हरेः वासः सप्तमः”

Fulfilment of Sahasra Chandi Maha Yagam accordingly calls for such recitations for 1000 times to be followed by Prayoga Homam thereafter. Sahasrachandi is performed to invoke the potential force of Shakthi to promote

tranquility, happiness and general welfare in the society, warding off calamities of all kinds. The universe is dependent on Her and seeks Her blessings even when they are devoid of desires.

When she is worshipped and propitiated, she resides in the house of Her devotees as Lakshmi, the presiding deity of prosperity.

“लक्ष्मी वृद्धि प्राधा ग्रेः” as the script says,

“प्रथमानि श्लोकत्रयं स्मरामि धर्मस्य गणितं धर्मसंशयम्।”

propitiated the devotee receives enough wealth, good progeny, dharmic intellect and a very auspicious life here and hereafter.

Sahasra Chandi would be performed between Monday 22.09.2025 and Thursday 02.10.2025 under the guidance of Br. Sri. Dinakara Sharma of Kumbakonam.

SRI KAMAKSHI KANAKA DHARANA MAHIMA

(Adorning Gold)

Jaganmatha Sri Kamakshi Devi, the aradhya devatha of the Shankaracharyas of Sri Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam, is the embodiment of Tri Shaktis, Sri Durga, Lakshmi and Saraswathi and she blesses all through her eyes. “கண்ணாலே அருள் தரும் நாயகி”. Among various descriptions of Amba, some most important ones are “hiranya varnam harini”, “taam agnivarnam” i.e. Amba is as resplendent as gold and shines like fire which in turn is golden in colour. Among various blessings that we receive from Amba, she is praised as “Vasu dha” bestower of gold i.e. prosperity. Hence Gold is strongly linked to Jaganmatha who embodies wealth, prosperity, and good fortune. Images of Amba often depict her showering gold coins, symbolising her ability to bestow abundance and success. Gold is seen as a symbol of purity and light, reflecting the sun’s radiant energy and representing the divine glow and It is believed to purify the body and mind. Golden colour itself is associated with Amba’s illumination. Sri Lalitha Sahasranama the most important 1000 unique names of Amba which describe almost all aspects of Jaganmatha with no names repeated, but the word implying Swarna (gold) repeats as “Sarva Abarana Bhoosana” and “Swarna Garbha” emphasising the importance of gold ornament and gold by itself being Amba. To commemorate this importance, a gold coated ornament of 1000 coins with each coin bearing one of the 1000 names in the Lalitha Sahasranama is planned to be adorned on Amba Sri Kamakshi during this Navarathri by the Jagadguru Sankaracharyas of Sri Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam. Tri Shakti Utsavam thus enabling all the devotees to have darshan of Jaganmatha Sri Kamakshi Devi resplendent with this divine Jewel. This darshanam of Sri Kamakshi, while dispelling all negativity will shower all prosperity to the devotees. All are requested to make use of this rare opportunity and be the recipients of the blessings being showered by Sri Kamakshi Devi and the Shankaracharyas of Sri Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam.



A gold Kasumalai would also be offered to the Jaganmatha at the beginning of the Sarada Navarathri Utsavam.

Ashwa or a horse is revered as symbol of royalty, power, prosperity, strength and seen as loyal companions and protectors. Hence Ashwa is worshipped during the first three days as Durga.
