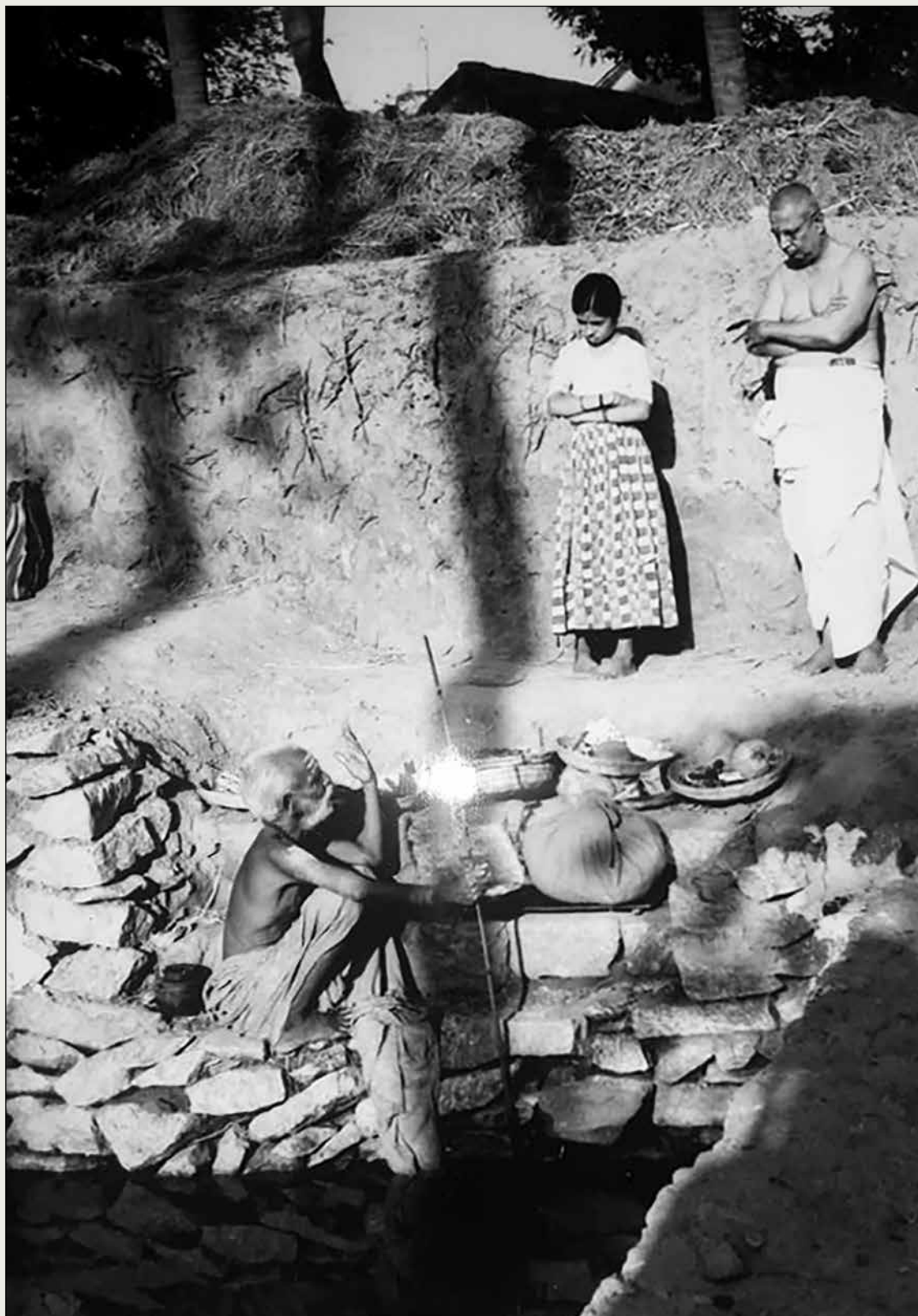

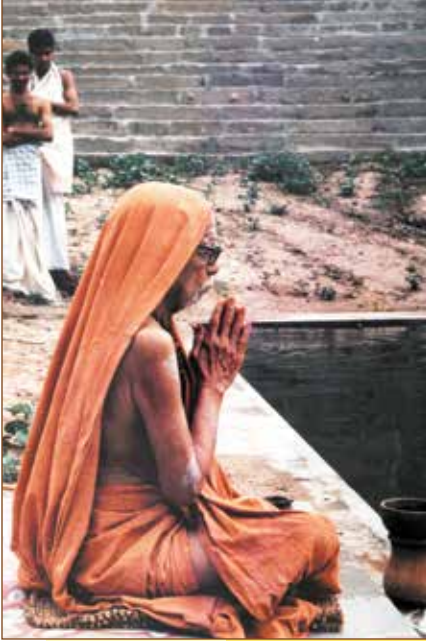

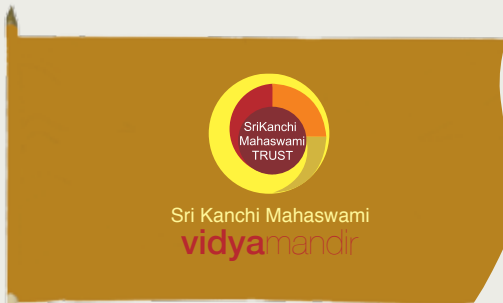
## DUAL EDUCATION

# SRI KANCHI MAHASWAMI TRUST ANNUAL REPORT 2019-20



The trustees have pleasure in presenting the Annual Report for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020. The activities of the year were a significant step forward in realising the objects of the Trust. The onset of Coronavirus necessitated cancellation of various activities and programs in March 2020. The Annual examinations of CBSE were completed just in time while the vedic school could not hold its Varshika Pariksha. The other highlights of the year were :

1. 'Anugraha Varsha', exhibition on the life and times of the Mahaswami of Kanchi

was inaugurated on 21<sup>st</sup> January 2020 by Shri. Mohan Bhagwat, Sarsanghachalak, Rashtriya Swayam Sevak Sangh (RSS) in the benign presence of His Holiness Pujyasri Sankara Vijayendra Saraswati Swamigal and Swami Omkarananda.

2. The trust took on hand the various additional constructions in the campus – 12 additional classrooms by renovating and modifying Jagadguru Nivas, photo exhibition gallery in the first floor of the multipurpose hall



3. The Sri. Kanchi Mahaswami Vidya Mandir continued its success trail by recording 100% results for the fifth time in both the Xth and XIIth standard examinations of CBSE.
4. The Sri Kanchi Mahaswami Vidya Mandir submitted its proposal for International Best School Award from British Council. Upon successful completion of the same, it shall apply for accreditation to the National Board of Education and Training (NABET) of the Quality Council of India.
5. The project 'Jayendram' exhibition on the life and times of Pujyasri Jayendra Saraswati Swamigal and 'Kanchi Kosh' on the history of Sri. Kanchi Mutt have been approved for implementation.

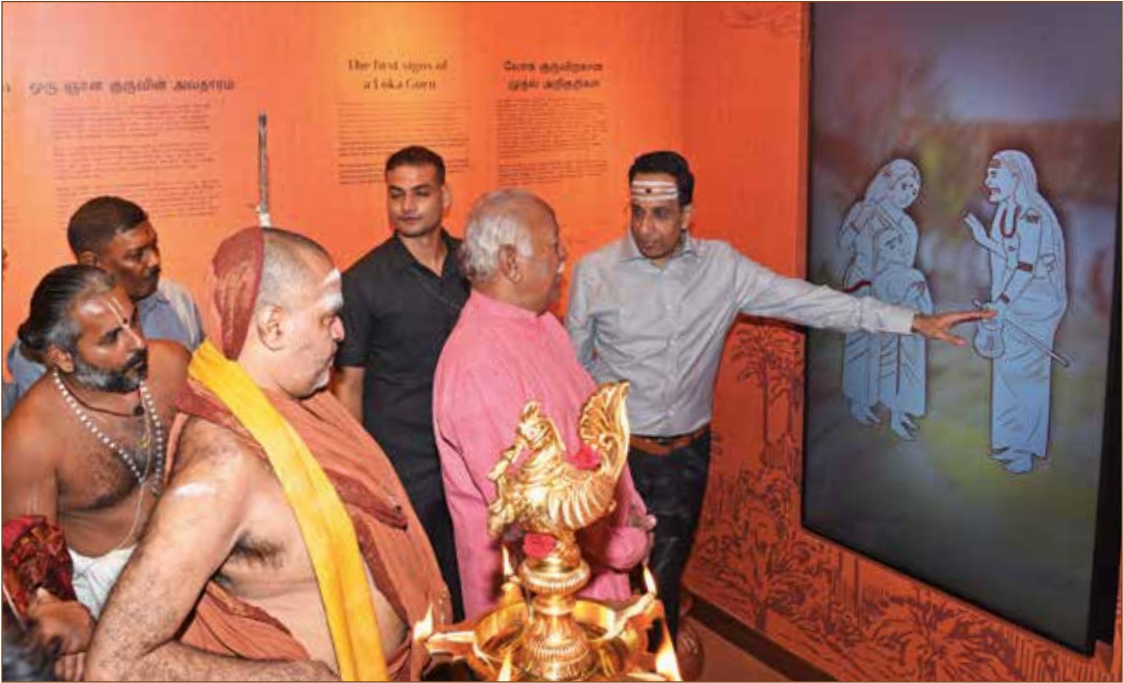
(Param Vaani) and Namadhu Dharmam based on the discourses of the Mahaswami during his first Vijaya Yatra to Chennapattinam in 1932 were released on the occasion. Master Priyavrata Patil was honoured with a cash prize of Rs. 1.0 lakh. He cleared the 'Tenali Maha Pariksha' conducted by Sri. Kanchee Veda Vedanta Shastra Sabha, all the 14 parts at the young age of 16. He completed it in 2 years against the regular 7 years of full time study. He hails from Rivona Village, Goa. His parents Shri. Devadutta Govind Patil and Sow. Dr. Aparna Patil were also honoured. Shri. Devadutta Govind Patil cleared the Tenali Maha Pariksha twice. He has studied Nyaya and Mimamsa and currently teaches them to 16 students. Dr. Aparna Patil is a scholar in ancient texts.

In Anugraha Varsha, a total of 56 exhibits are on display. The Exhibition is divided into the following sections.

The exhibition was made at a cost of Rs. 1,07,49,802/-.















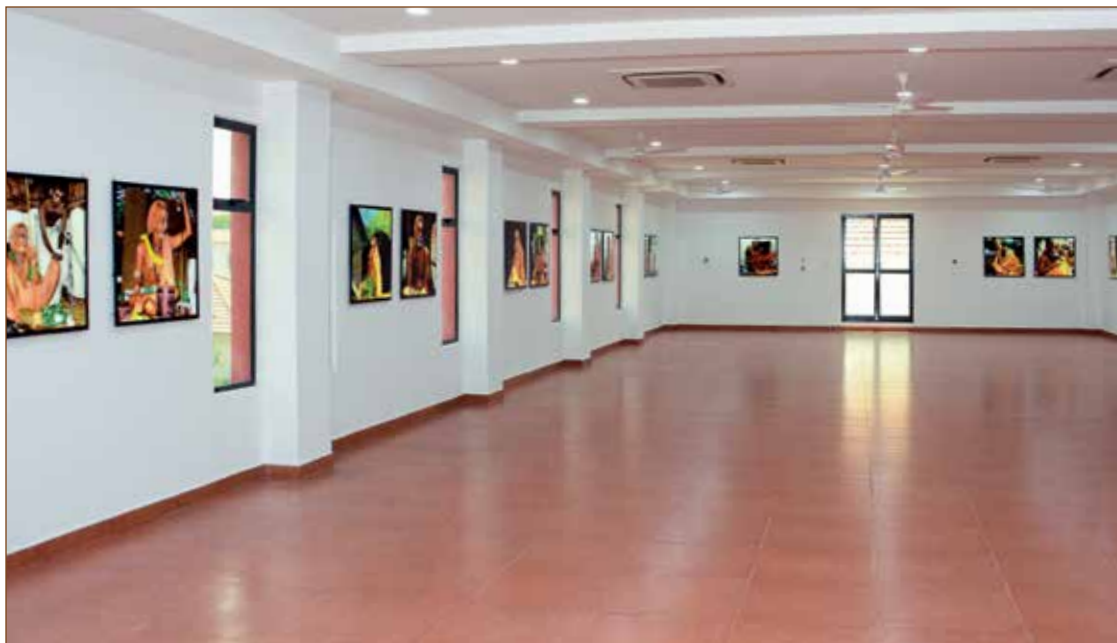
## BHAGAVAD PADA VIDYARTHA NISHKEPA TRUST

**T**his trust was amalgamated with our trust vide order and judgement dated 27.10.2017 by Assistant Charity Commissioner, Greater Mumbai Region, Dharmadhay Ayukta. Accordingly, all the assets of this trust were merged into the assets of our trust effective 19th October 2014. The Assets include land and building at Plot 56 (Old 109) Rama Naicken Street, Nungambakkam, Chennai – 600034. This residential property is of no utility to our Trust and is located 25 kms away from Tambaram (East) where the Vidya Mandir is located. It was also being encroached frequently. The trust had to maintain the property from its resources without commensurate benefits. An application was filed before the Jt. Charity Commissioner, Mumbai on 22nd May 2018 for approval for alienation of this property under section 36 of the Maharashtra Public Trusts Act, 1950. Vide his order dated 18th August 2018, the Jt. Charity Commissioner rejected the application on the ground that it was not in the interest

of the Trust. A Writ Petition No. 12035 of 2018 was filed in the Bombay High Court against this order. The High Court vide its order dated 25th April 2019 directed the Jt. Charity Commissioner to consider the application afresh. On his rejecting the alienation vide his order dated 29th May 2019, the Trust moved the Bombay High Court again seeking to quash this order. Vide its order dated 28th June 2019, the High Court was pleased to approve the sale of the property at a price not less than Rs. 1.10 crores to Shri. V. Gowrishankaran, the prospective buyer. As the buyer resiled on his purchase, the trust again moved the High Court to authorise the sale in favour of anyone at a price not less than Rs. 1.50 crores. This application in the Writ Petition is pending hearing and disposal. The trust is confident of getting a favourable order to dispose off the property. The net sale proceeds will be credited to the corpus fund of the Trust.



## EXTENSION OF THE FIRST FLOOR OF THE MULTIPURPOSE HALL



**T**he 100 photo frames of the Mahaswami capturing his divinity, compassion, simplicity and saintliness adorn the three floors of the Multipurpose hall. It has been proposed to convert this Multipurpose Hall into 'Sri Kanchi Varalaru', an exhibition on the glory of the venerated Kamakoti Peetam. The Mahaswami Photo Exhibition is proposed to be shifted to the extension of the first floor 86'10" x 35'5" measuring 3075 sq.ft. The Architects have estimated the cost of the extension as under :

## EXTENSION BLOCK TO CBSE SENIOR SCHOOL



12 ADDITIONAL CLASS ROOMS

**J**agadguru Nivas was constructed in the campus for the stay of the Jagadgurus during their visit to the campus. The Nivas, over the last six years, has been put to minimal use as occasions for the visit of the Acharyas were less. With the increasing enrolment in the CBSE School, the need for expansion has arisen. It was decided to modify the Jagadguru Nivas and add an extension block to the CBSE School as would create 12 additional class rooms. The project commenced on 26th February 2020 and would be completed by September 2020. The civil work has been assigned to Sakthi Builders at a cost of Rs. 1,65,35,593/-

excluding GST, the total civil cost being Rs. 1,95,12,000/-. Alongwith electrical work and furniture fittings and fixtures, the cost of expansion would be Rs. 2.50 crores. With augmentation of space, the CBSE school alongwith the Primary section can enrol a minimum of 1500 students.

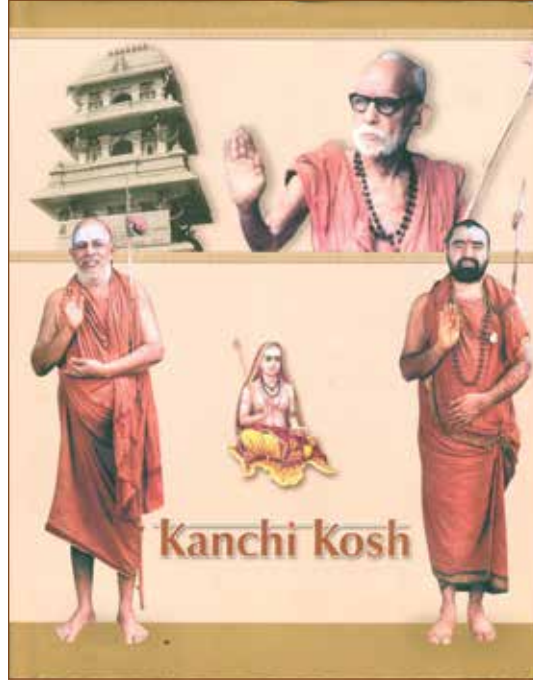

An additional outlay of about Rs. 3.50 crores including the construction of the first floor addition is envisaged. In the aggregate, the

final cost of the Exhibition Project would be about Rs. 12.00 crores.



## BOOKS / PUBLICATIONS SALE

The Trust has over the years brought out several publications mainly based on the discourses of the Mahaswami of Kanchi. “Deivathin Kural” was translated – the seven volumes into English, Hindi, Marathi, Kannada and a volume each in Bengali and Assamese. 4 volumes of the Telugu edition have been printed and two further volumes have been translated. Despite our best efforts, the Telugu translation has been moving in fits and starts. It is hoped to complete it before year end. The books and publications sales division of Sri. Kanchi Mutt has emerged as the major outlet for sale of these books at cost. In addition, a discount of 20% is offered to the Mutt. During the year till February 2020, Rs. 6,37,400/- was paid by the Mutt. The actual sale gross of discount was Rs. 7,96,750/-

## SUPPLY OF PROVISIONS AND VEGETABLES TO SRI KANCHI MUTT

With the blessings of His Holiness Pujyasri Sankara Vijayendra Saraswati Swamigal of the Sri. Kanchi Mutt, free boarding and lodging is provided to poor students pursuing engineering and other degree programmes in the SSCMV University, Enathur. Even the education is free. At no cost, the students can complete the courses of their choice. At the request of the Mutt, it was agreed to supply all the provisions and vegetables for the students through Veda Sastra Pandit Raksha Sabha. During the period April 2019 – February 2020, an amount of Rs. 4,51,722/- was paid to S. Arunasalam Chettiar Company for supply of provisions. Vegetables were sourced from Thalasingam vegetable shop. During the period 1.4.2019 – 29.2.2020, an amount of Rs. 2,82,610/- was paid to them for supply of vegetables.
